



# **OFFICIAL RULES**

Albany Broadcasting, Hinny Hard Seltzer and Lion Heart Pub its subsidiaries and affiliated companies (together, the “Company”), will conduct the Contest substantially as described in these rules, and by participating, each participant agrees as follows:

**Contest: Wednesday May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2024 from 5pm – 7pm**

**100.9 & 107.9 The Cat, Hinny Hard Seltzer and Lion Heart Pub will host the contest known as “First Annual Morgan Wallen Commemorative Chair Toss Competition” where TEN (10) listeners will have a chance to toss a chair the furthest distance to will win a pair of PIT tickets to see Morgan Wallen at Metlife Stadium on Friday May 17<sup>th</sup>, 2024.**

**The decision of the 100.9 & 107.1 The Cat judges is final.**

**To participate in this contest, you MUST BE at least 18 years of age.**

## **How to Enter:**

From Monday May 6th, 2024 through Friday May 10<sup>th</sup>, 2024 contests will be chosen twice a day on air by being caller number nineteen (19) on the station request line at 518-476-1009 at 7:10am and 3:10pm.

**NO PURCHASE NECESSARY.  
PURCHASE DOES NOT INCREASE ODDS OF WINNING.  
Void where prohibited.**

**Any discrepancies will be handled by staff of 100.9 & 107.9 The Cat.  
All decisions of the judges will be final.**

**100.9 & 107.9 The Cat, Albany Broadcasting, Hinny Hard Seltzer, Lion Heart Pub, MetLife Stadium, Big Loud Records, their employees and subsidiaries ARE NOT responsible for “cost” to participate in this contest. Examples of “costs” are, but not limited to, personal time, gas, entry fee, parking costs, additional charges outside of the cost of the tickets, etc.**

**All ten (10) contests are participating in this contest of their own free will.**

**How the contest works:**

- You must arrive at Lion Heart on the Green at 952 Broadway, Albany, NY 12207 by 5pm on Wednesday, May 15th for the contest.
- You may select 1 (one) alternate person as your designated chair tosser.
- NO modifications to the chair can be made and you must throw the chair provided.
- The contest will be BEST of 3 throws
- Your throw must begin behind the designated throw line.
- Your feet must be firmly planted on the ground behind the throw line (no running or step starts)
- Length of throw will be measured by the furthest tip of the chair when it comes to a complete rest.
- Winner must be able to attend the Morgan Wallen concert on Friday, May 17th, 2024 at Metlife stadium or the next runner up will be awarded the prize.
- Rules are subject to change at the discretion of the judges.
- All decisions are at the discretion of the judges and decisions are final.

**General Rules:**

1. By participating in this contest and/or accepting any prize in this contest, the winner releases 100.9 & 107.9 The Cat, Albany Broadcasting, Hinny Hard Seltzer, Lion Heart Pub, MetLife Stadium, Big Loud Records and any additional participating sponsor(s) from any and all liabilities associated with the contest and/or said prize.
2. Decisions of the 100.9 & 107.1 The Cat judges are final.

3. 100.9 & 107.9 The Cat, Albany Broadcasting, Hinny Hard Seltzer, Lion Heart Pub, MetLife Stadium, Big Loud Records reserves the right to end the contest at any time for any reason without notice.
4. Void where prohibited by law.
5. Anyone, 18 years or older, living or working in the WKLI (100.9/107.1 THE CAT) listening area is eligible to enter. Provided they meet criteria established within these rules.
6. No purchase necessary.
7. Each finalist must sign a release form and a copy of the rules prior to the contest.
8. Participants agree to have their voices, pictures, web cam video transmissions, names and likeness used by 100.9 & 107.9 The Cat, Albany Broadcasting, Hinny Hard Seltzer, Lion Heart Pub, MetLife Stadium, Big Loud Records for promotional and publicity purposes without compensation. Furthermore, participants agree to have their conversations taped for broadcast or played on the air without further notice.
9. Employees of WKLI, Pamal Broadcasting, other Broadcast Groups, Hinny Hard Seltzer, Lion Heart Pub, MetLife Stadium, Big Loud Records, other participating sponsors and their families are not eligible to participate in this contest.
10. 100.9 & 107.9 The Cat, Albany Broadcasting, Hinny Hard Seltzer, Lion Heart Pub, MetLife Stadium, Big Loud Records reserve the right to revise any of these rules at any time.

**Winners:**

Prizes are not transferable, redeemable for cash or exchangeable for any other prize. Tickets will be available for winner(s) at will call at the box office at MetLife Stadium on Friday, May 17th. If a winner cannot attend or is disqualified, the Company reserves the right to determine an alternate winner or not to award that winner's prize, in its sole discretion.

**Prizes:**

One (1) winner will be awarded a pair (2 tickets) of Pitt Passes to see Morgan Wallen on Friday, May 17<sup>th</sup> at MetLife Stadium and one (1) one hundred dollar (\$100) gift card. Tickets will be available for winner(s) at will call at the box office at MetLife Stadium on Friday, May 17<sup>th</sup>. Gift card must be picked up by the winner at Company's station location (6 Johnson Road, Latham, NY 12110) during open business hours, within 30 days of notification that the prize is available. Winner must present photo identification. If winner is unable to pick up prize themselves they may notify the station — at the time of winning — that a substitute may pick up the prize for them. By notifying the station that the substitute may pick up their prize, station disclaims all liability for any miss-delivery, loss or failure of delivery. Substitute must show their identification to claim prize for the winner

**Eligibility and Limitations:**

Participants and winner(s) must be U.S. residents at least 18-years old as determined by the Company. Only one (1) entry per person. Only one (1) prize per household for the Contest. Only one (1) prize per household from any of the Company's stations within any thirty (30) day period. Employees of the Company, Destination Kia, the Contest's participating sponsors and their advertising agencies, employees of other radio or television stations, and members of the immediate family of any such persons are not eligible to participate and win. The term "immediate family" includes spouses, siblings, parents, children, grandparents and grandchildren, whether as "in-laws," or by current or past marriage(s), remarriage(s), adoption, co-habitation or other family extension, and any other persons residing at the same household whether or not related. No proxies or substitutions are allowed for this contest. If for ANY reason, the qualifying contestant is unable to attend the grand prize event (ie. Schedule, disqualification, etc.), he/she forfeits their chance at the grand prize. If a qualifying prize was part of the contest, he/she is still eligible to receive said prize.

**Release.** By participating in the Contest, each participant and winner waives any and all claims of liability against the Company, Destination Kia, its employees and agents, the Contest's sponsors and their respective employees and agents, for any personal injury or loss which may occur from the conduct of, or participation in, the Contest, or from the use of any prize. All entries become the property of the Company and will not be returned.

Station(s) shall follow the applicable laws for conducting contests, including notice to the state attorney general or consumer affairs office, posting of a prize bond, furnishing lists of winners, running specific on-air disclaimers, providing specific written information about the Contest, etc. as required by local and state law.
