

In 2017, WASR's website stream was listened to for 1,250,000+ minutes by 57,000+ unique online listeners.

Our FM & AM broadcasts have an estimated audience of 60,000+ listeners weekly. With an ad airing twice a day for five days, WASR offers 500,000+ touch points to listeners based on the population of our coverage area. The majority of our audience has an annual household income of over \$75,000. WASR's FM and AM signals both offer full coverage of the Route 16 corridor from Rochester to Conway, the only major north and south highway route through eastern New Hampshire.

In order to appeal to a broad demographic ranging from young families to our retired communities, WASR broadcasts community news and events, original and syndicated programming, up to date weather, Westwood News, and the best music mix.
