
WHY RADIO?

We broadcast from our studios in Peterhead on FM, DAB, Smart Speakers, on mobile apps, Radioplayer, TV services and multiple other online services.

Our broadcast organically reaches the major towns in the North east of Scotland including ABERDEEN, PETERHEAD, FRASERBURGH, STONEHAVEN, BANFF, ALFORD, INVERURIE


WE DO DIGITAL
