


OUR AUDIENCE

CHON-FM's extensive radio network consists of studio, production, transmission and state of the art satellite distribution facilities in Whitehorse.

The network has 27 rebroadcast sites in Yukon, Northern British Columbia and the Northwest Territories.

CHON-FM broadcasts on 98.1 FM in Whitehorse, and 90.5 FM in most other communities in Yukon, Northern BC and Western NWT - as well streaming live 24/7 on our website, cable TV & satellite radio.






