

2020 Hidden Valley Lake Boat Driver Exam

All residents applying for a boat sticker must take this exam and answer **all** questions correctly prior to receiving their stickers. All answers to the questions below are disclosed on the enclosed Lake Rules.

THE PERSON TAKING THE EXAM IS RESPONSIBLE FOR INFORMING ALL PERSONS OPERATING HIS/HER BOAT OF HVL RULES.

MULTIPLE CHOICE: *Circle the letter of the correct answer*

- To register your water craft you must:
 - be a HVL POA member in good standing
 - pay the appropriate water craft registration fees
 - provide a certificate showing current water craft liability insurance
 - all of the above
- A water craft may pull or tow a maximum of how many persons at a time in the high-speed zone regardless of the type of device being pulled or towed:
 - As many as you wish
 - Three (3)
 - Two (2)
 - One (1)
- Watercraft picking up a downed skier, tuber or wake boarder must immediately slow down to a no-wake idle speed and:
 - turn to the left for pick up
 - turn to the right for pick up
 - wait for them to swim to the boat
 - cut in front of another boat to pick them up
- When on the lake, **all** watercraft must be equipped with US Coast Guard approved PFD's totaling:
 - amount equal to or greater than the number of people
 - One (1) for each seat on the boat
 - two (2) times the number of persons on board
 - Five (5)
- Water craft may **NOT** perform the following while operating at high-speed:
 - travel clockwise around the lake
 - perform "S" turns
 - perform "figure 8" turns
 - all of the above

- A watercraft may pull or tow only one person at a time in a high-speed zone, except on a tube where you can pull 2 people.

- The use of installed boat devices and/or boat operations that cause the creation of damaging or dangerous wake are prohibited on the HVL Main Lake.

- All powered watercraft must travel in a clockwise direction within the high-speed zone on the main lake except when picking up a downed skier, tuber, wake boarder or a person from a flotation device.

- All watercraft are required to have lights equipped and illuminated when operating in the lake between sunset and sunrise.

- The HVL POA member to whom the watercraft is registered is responsible for the safe and proper operation of the watercraft.
