

Moose FM Block Party COVID-19 Plan

General Guidance

- If you have any signs or symptoms of COVID-19, please do not attend the event. If you are displaying symptoms of COVID-19 you will be refused entry.
- Each performance will be limited to 50 guests
- All staff, volunteers and performers will be screened for COVID-19 symptoms before they start their shift.
- Staff, volunteers and performers will participate in a pre-shift meeting to ensure all staff understand the protocols in place.
- Contact information for at least one person from each group will be collected at the time tickets are issued to help with any possible contact tracing.
- The theatre will undergo enhanced sanitization and disinfection throughout the day. In between performances, a sprayer and disinfectant will be used throughout the facility. Each washroom will be cleaned between performances and high touch services will be disinfected.
- All staff and volunteers will wear a mask while assisting any guests.
- The theatre has removed common contact items from all tables.
- Tickets will need to be booked in advance. You will only be able to book tickets in groups of four or six. Once tickets are booked, a seating plan will be created to maintain proper distances between all tables.
- This seating plan cannot be changed. There will be a minimum of two metres between all guests. Other tables and booths will be marked as closed.
- When you arrive for the event, watch for markers on the floor and remain at least two metres from any other guests.
- Please be kind and patient with others.
- No outside food or drink will be allowed at this event.

Performers

- The performers will be tested for COVID-19 before travelling to the event. They will travel by vehicle from Edmonton to Fort St. John and only stop as needed. They will then stay at a hotel in Fort St. John while they are in the community.
- During the performance, they will remain on the stage at all times. Guests will be seated at least three metres away from the stage or performance area.

Facility

- Hand sanitizer will be provided at entrances, exits, tables, bathrooms and other common areas.
- Washrooms will be cleaned after each performance.
- Staff will perform hand hygiene frequently and diligently.
- The concession will be closed and a staff member of the Lido will come to a table to take any orders. A limited menu will be available and the server will wear a mask at all times.
