A PROCLAMATION BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL

WHEREAS there is a pandemic of Coronavirus (also known as Covid-19);

WHEREAS that disease is not at present circulating in the island;

AND WHEREAS it is no longer necessary for existing measures to control the disease to continue in operation (except to the extent provided for in continuation regulations under section 4A of the Emergency Powers Act 1936);

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 3 of the Emergency Powers Act 1936, the Governor in Council makes the following proclamation:

State of emergency

A state of emergency no longer exists on the Isle of Man and accordingly the proclamation made on 15th June 2020 shall cease to have effect on the coming into operation of this proclamation.

Commencement

This proclamation comes into operation at 6.00p.m. on 26th June 2020.
