

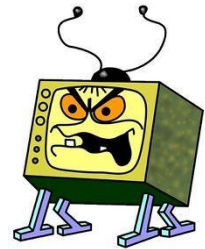

PENSIONS AND PENSIONERS

- ❖ Ensure That The Basic Pension Is Sufficient To Give A Fair Standard Of Living; Pensioners Should Be Given Assistance To Remain In Their Own Homes And Maintain Independent Flexible, Personal Care And Support Budget To Enhance Choices. They Should Be Given A Good System Of Support For Family Members Who Care For Dependent Relatives.
- ❖ We Must Tackle The Public Pension Crisis. There Should Be No Fixed Pension Age, People Should Be Given The Choice To Retire Earlier If They Want Or To Keep Working As Long As They Want. The Government Should Offer Tailor Made Pension Packages To Reflect This.
- ❖ New Entrants To The Civil Service Should Pay More Towards Their Pensions To Protect The NI Fund From Running Out Of Money.

TV AND RADIO COVERAGE

- ❖ The Isle Of Man Gets Poor Value For The Tv Licence Fee; We Must Press For More Refund Of The Fee To Fund More Media And Better Coverage. Also We Need To Ensure That The Over 75's Continue To Receive A Free TV Licence.



OUR DEMOCRACY

- ❖ I Strongly Believe That Members Of The Legislative Council Should Be Elected By The Public In A National Poll.
- ❖ We Need To Look At Removing Collective Responsibility As I Believe This Is Highly Undemocratic As Ministers End Up Having To Vote Against Their And The Constituents Beliefs Just To Keep Their Ministerial Position As The Public Have Voted Them In As Independent MHK's So We Need To Ensure That The Ministers Get A Free Vote On Each Issue.



LOCAL ISSUES

- ❖ Parts of the Middle constituency have very poor bus services areas such as Mount Rule, West Baldwin, East Baldwin Etc Don't Have Any Bus Service At All, At The Very Least We Need To Look At Extending The Dial A Ride Service To Cover These And Any Other Areas Where There's A Need As Surely There's Elderly And Vulnerable People In Need Of Some Kind Of Bus Service.
- ❖ There Are Some Issues With Speeding Traffic On Some Of The Roads In Middle. I Would Support More Pedestrian Crossings Where It's Dangerous For Pedestrians In The Community To Cross The Road Safely As This Would Slow Down The Traffic And Make It Easier And Safer For People To Cross The Road.

LAW AND ORDER

- ❖ The Isle Of Man Is Still One Of The Safest Places To Live And We Must Ensure This Continues By Providing Adequate Resources For This Vital Service And Make Sure It Runs Efficiently. We Must Make Sure Home Security Is A Priority To Prevent Burglaries And Crime. The Uk Has Introduced Id Control Before You Can Leave The Country, But We Don't Collect Any Data On People Coming To The Iom. We Need Advanced Passenger Information (api) Available To The Police And Law Enforcement Agencies To Aid In The Prevention And Detection Of Crime. I Believe That API Will Make The Island A Much Safer Place To Live. As At The Moment No-One Shows Any ID When They Come Here On The Ferry So Paedophiles And Drug Dealers Etc Can Come Here Undetected At The Moment, API Would Allow The Police Force Here To Know Who Exactly Is On The Island And Monitor And Track Suspicious People Here To Keep The Island A Safer Place So Its Paramount That API Comes In Sooner Rather Than Later.
- ❖ We Need To Make Sure That There's A System In Place To Prevent Unduly Lenient Sentences Given Out To Serious Criminals.
- ❖ Look At Developing A Formal Independent Police Complaints Commission.
- ❖ I Fully Support The Use Of ANPR Cameras As It's Only Fair That Everyone Should Pay The Road Tax So There's Enough Money To Keep The Roads Maintained.
- ❖ I Would Also Support Stiffer Penalties For Road Tax Evasion.



PUBLIC FINANCES

- ❖ There's Not Enough Time For The Public And Politicians To Give The Budget Proper Scrutiny Before It's Voted On. It Should Be Voted Through In Tranches.

HEALTH

- ❖ Health Is A High Priority As We Must Ensure That We Have On-Island Health Care And Expertise Whenever Possible, Reduce Waiting Lists And Ensure Sufficient Provision Of Nhs Dentistry As Well As Protecting The Frontline Staff And Services. We Need To Reduce The Dependence Of Expensive Locums And Bring In Specialists Over To The Island To Reduce The Number Of Elderly Patient Transfers.
- ❖ Invest In Our Mental Health Professionals And Support Networks.
- ❖ I Support The Development Of A Sexual Assault Referral Centre As Currently Rape Victims Have To Travel To The Uk.
- ❖ We Need To Look At Whether We Can Reinstate The Meals On Wheels Subsidy So Its Run As A High Quality Service By The Salvation Army Again, It Was Good Value For The Taxpayer, Cutting Of This Was A Step Too Far.

GOVERNMENT WASTE

- ❖ I Am **NOT** In Favour Of Wholesale Privatisation But Believe We Should Corporatise Some Public Services Which Means The Government Working With Specialists In The Private Sector To Operate And Manage Public Facilities. Public Private Partnerships Are A Proven Way Of Providing Better Value For The Taxpayer.
- ❖ Significant Savings And Improved Productivity Can Be Delivered Through Simplifying The Bureaucratic Way In Which The Government Employs And Manages Staff.
- ❖ Also, Expanding Provision Of Online Services Can Create Savings.
- ❖ Reduce The Vast Cost Of External Consultants By Empowering Government Managerial And Technical Staff To Make Decisions.
- ❖ I Am Also Not In Favour Of A Wholesale Cull Of Civil Servants As This Would Just Translate Employment To Unemployment So This Must Be A Gradual, Well Thought-Out Transition Formed On Proper Business Goals.
- ❖ Efficiencies Don't Mean Cutbacks, It Just Means Running The Same services Better AT A Lower Cost.



HEMP / CANNABIS

I Want To See The Isle Of Man Growing Medical Cannabis Here Which Is Produced By The Female Plant As This Will Be A Great Boost To The Economy And Could Create 200 Or More Jobs In This Sector.

I Want To See Full Support For The Farmers, They Need To Be Granted A Licence To Grow Hemp Which Produces The Industrial Products Such As Hemp For Producing Rope And Clothing And Reinforcing Concrete Etc. The Male Seed Is Much Cheaper Than The Female Seed And Is Easier And Cheaper To Grow. The Seed And The Oil From The Seed Is Highly Nutritious, It's Considered To Be More Healthy Than Olive Oil So The Seed And The Oil Are Very Valuable. It Can Also Be Attributed To Producing More Than 25,000 Products. It's Also A Very Hardy Plant And Shouldn't Require Any Chemicals To Grow It. It Is Also A Very Good Pollinator For Bees And Other Beneficial Insects. RATES REFORM

- ❖ I Don't Agree With Some MHK's Views Of Having A Banding System Where People With Medium And Larger Houses Could End Up Paying A Lot More Council Rates, Water Rates And Sewerage Charges Which Is An Unfair Burden As Their Bills Are High Enough Already. If Elected I Will Fight Very Hard To Stop This As It Would Be A **Very Unfair** Burden On The Rate Payers. I Do Not Want To See The Rate Payers Of Middle Burdened With A Mansion Tax. I Would Also Like To See Single Occupancy Households Being Granted A 25% Discount Off Their Rates. It Has Also Come To Light That The Government Plans To Spend £2 Million On A Rates Review, What A Waste Of Money! I Believe An All Island Rating System Would Be Detrimental To The Residents Of Middle And Will Not Support It.

AIRPORT

- ❖ In 2010 The Airport Director And The Infrastructure Minister Said That If It Was Run On Commercial Lines It Would Have A Cost Saving Of At Least £2million Per Year. If Elected I Will Push This Issue Hard To Get The Savings In Place.



CYCLING

- ❖ I Am A Keen Cyclist And Will Back Kate's Law Ensuring A Safe Gap Away From A Bicycle When A Vehicle Overtakes. Also All Cyclists Should Have The Minimum Of A High-Viz Vest In The Darker Half Of The Year. Also A Lot Of Glens Don't Have Facilities To Lock Your Bike This Needs Addressing. Also We Need To Look At Putting More Cycle Lanes In Where Practical.

TOURISM

- ❖ We Must Continue To Support And Promote The TT And Other Motorsport Events As They Are A Vital Part Of The Manx Economy And The Manx Way Of Life, But Also We Must Do More To Promote Eco-Tourism, Landscape And Wildlife Of The Island And Promote Our Heritage. Back In 2010 Centreparks Came To The Island Keen On Setting Up A Centre Here, But The Government At The Time Pushed Them Away, We Need To Get Them Back Here Talking Again As This Will Be A Great Benefit To The Manx Economy If We Can Get Them To Build A Centreparks Centre Here, I'd Like To See Them As Part Of The Planning Deal Having To Plant Lots Of Trees Surrounding The Site As Part Of The Condition For Getting Permission. Also We Need To Look At Whether We Could Have A Sealife Centre Somewhere On The Island Which Would Also Boost Tourism. Also In The Longer Term We Should Be Looking At Whether We Can Attract A Company To Set Up A Theme Park Here.
